First aid allowance	\$0.48 per hour up to a maximum of \$18.16 per week
Laundry allowance - full-time	\$11.98 per week
Laundry allowance - part-time & casual	\$2.36 per shift
Meal allowance	\$9.69 for the meal or meals provided
Transfer from job-to-job - travelling time allowance	payment at the appropriate rate for time spent travelling
Transfer from job-to-job - travel costs reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of travel expenses
