Allowances	Rate
Country work - lodging allowance	\$86.35 per night
Country work - travel time allowance	payment at the minimum hourly rate for each hour of travel to and from country work
First aid allowance	\$0.38 per hour up to a maximum of \$14.52 per week
First aid kit reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of maintaining a first aid kit
Fumigation depot allowance	\$6.37 for each day such work is performed
Verminous/decomposed human body allowance	\$81.89 on each occasion
Leading hand - in charge of 2-10 employees - payment in addition to the minimum wage for the highest classification supervised, or own minimum wage, whichever is higher	\$0.72 per hour up to a maximum of \$27.32 per week
Leading hand - in charge of 11-21 employees - payment in addition to the minimum wage for the highest classification supervised, or own minimum wage, whichever is higher	\$1.08 per hour up to a maximum of \$40.88 per week
Leading hand - in charge of more than 21 employees - payment in addition to the minimum wage for the highest classification supervised, or own minimum wage, whichever is higher	\$1.46 per hour up to a maximum of \$55.53 per week
Meal allowance	\$13.09 per meal
Vehicle allowance	\$0.78 per km
