Distant work onshore - travelling time - Monday to Saturday - overnight travel with sleeping berth	payment at the minimum hourly rate with a maximum payment of 8 hours out of every 24 hours
Distant work onshore - travelling time - Sundays and public holidays - no overnight travel	payment at the minimum hourly rate plus 50% with a maximum payment of 12 hours out of every 24 hours
Distant work onshore - travelling time - Sundays and public holidays - overnight travel without sleeping berth	payment at the minimum hourly rate plus 50% with a maximum payment of 12 hours out of every 24 hours
Distant work onshore - travelling time - Sundays and public holidays - overnight travel with sleeping berth	payment at the minimum hourly rate plus 50% with a maximum payment of 8 hours out of every 24 hours
Distant work onshore - travelling expenses	\$5.91 to cover expenses of reaching home and transporting personal diving equipment
Distant work onshore - accommodation allowance - no agreement to secure own accommodation and meals	a minimum of \$47.47 per day or \$331.89 per week
Distant work onshore - accommodation allowance - agreement to secure own accommodation and meals	reimbursement for the cost of all meals and accommodation purchased while on board a vessel travelling offshore
Language allowance	\$1.15 per hour up to a maximum of \$43.85 per week
Loss of personal effects reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of personal effects lost with a maximum payment of \$2,364.00
Offshore meals and accommodation reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of all meals and accommodation purchased
Vehicle allowance	\$0.78 per km
