Allowances

If any all purpose allowances apply (marked *), they should be added to the minimum rate before penalties and overtime are calculated.

The allowances listed below do not apply to casuals unless specified in the label.

Bilge allowance	\$0.91 per hour
Charge hands allowance	\$0.71 per hour up to a maximum of \$26.96 per week
Charge hands allowance - not directly supervised by a foreman	\$1.06 per hour up to a maximum of \$40.10 per week
Chipping hammers, wire brushing or sandblasting machine allowance	\$0.08 per hour
Dirty work allowance working alongside vessels in discharging alumina, petroleum, coke, sulphur, anhydrous ammonia and all phosphates	\$1.49 per hour
Dirty work allowance	\$0.58 per hour
Distant work - working away from usual workplace - travelling time allowance	Payment at the minimum hourly rate per hour, up to a maximum of an ordinary days pay in any 24 hour period
Distant work - workplace away from usual workplace - travel fares reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of travel fares in excess of normal travel fares
Distant work - working away from usual workplace - temporary transfer allowance - per week of 7 days - including casuals	\$464.97 per week
Distant work - working away from usual workplace - temporary transfer allowance - broken part of a week - less than 7 days - including casuals	reimbursement of all living expenses up to a maximum of \$66.15 per day
Duties outside normal work - diving allowance	\$4.55 per day
Excess travelling time - travel to or from a starting or finishing point other than regular start or finish point	Payment at the minimum hourly rate of pay for excess travel time, with payment for at least 30 minutes and not more than 1 hour
First aid allowance	\$0.37 per hour up to a maximum of \$14.06 per week
General expenses	reimbursement of any expenses reasonably incurred
Living away from home allowance	reimbursement for the cost of meals and accommodation
Loading and unloading vessels allowance - 1-6 nights overnight cruises	\$16.62 per trip
Loading and unloading vessels allowance - more than 6 nights overnight cruises	\$24.81 per trip
Loading and unloading vessels allowance - transporting passengers and cargo between the mainland and island resorts - not day cruise - per week of 5 working days or less	\$4.94 per day up to a maximum of \$24.72 per week (of 5 days)
Loading and unloading vessels allowance - transporting passengers and cargo between the mainland and island resorts - not day cruise - per week of more than 5 working days	\$4.94 per day (up to a maximum of \$24.72 per week) for the first 5 days and \$5.04 per day for the 6th and 7th day

Meal allowance - overtime	\$16.10 for a meal and a further \$16.10 for a meal after 5.5 hours of overtime
* Non self-propelled bunker barges towing allowance - Masters	\$2.23 per day or part day when required to do such work
Waiting orders - telephone allowance - off-duty employee, phone not provided by employer	\$3.47 per call
Waiting orders - telephone allowance - not required to have telephone installed	\$136.52 per year plus annual rental
Waiting orders - telephone allowance - required to have telephone installed	\$136.52 per year plus annual rental and reimbursement for the installation fee
Slipway allowance - only junior employees	\$0.66 per hour

Starting, finishing or call out work between 11pm & 6am - transport not provided	Payment at the minimum hourly rate of pay for time spent travelling to or from home, with payment for at least 30 minutes and not more than 1 hour
Starting, finishing or call out work between 11pm & 6am - transport not provided - using own vehicle	\$0.78 per km
* Towing or carrying explosives allowance	\$2.40 per day or part day when required to do such work
Towing vessel beyond limits of harbour, river or bay	25% of the employee's normal wage for each day with a minimum payment for four hours
Travelling expenses reimbursement	reimbursement of all reasonable out of pocket expenses
Travelling to another port - Monday to Saturday	payment at the minimum hourly rate of pay for a maximum of 8 hours per day
Travelling to another port - Sundays and public holidays	payment at the minimum hourly rate of pay + 50% for a maximum of 8 hours per day
Travelling allowance - Different start and finish locations	overtime rates for excess travel time & payment for reasonable travelling expenses
Uniform allowance	\$0.44 per hour up to a maximum of \$16.62 per week
Unloading and loading garbage or ashes allowance	\$0.58 per hour
Vehicle allowance - travel to or from a starting or finishing point other than regular start or finish point	\$0.78 per km for the excess distance travelled
Wet work allowance	\$0.25 per hour
