Allowances

If any all purpose allowances apply (marked *), they should be added to the minimum rate before penalties and overtime are calculated.

| Allowances | Rate |
|---|--|
| Country work - travel time allowance | payment at the minimum hourly rate of pay for time spent travelling, with a maximum payment of 8 hours per day |
| Country work - travel expenses - meal allowance | \$14.80 per meal, with a maximum payment of 3 meals per day |
| Country work - travel expenses - overnight allowance | \$66.82 per night |
| Distant work - accommodation allowance whole week | \$479.52 per week for reasonable board and lodging |
| Distant work - accommodation allowance part of a week | reimbursement for the cost of all reasonable living expenses, up to a maximum of \$479.52 per week |
| Distant work - incidentals allowance | \$5.11 per night |
| Distant work - return home reimbursement | reimbursement for the cost of reasonable fares to return home for a weekend, on a maximum of 1 weekend every 4 weeks |
| First aid allowance | \$2.97 per day |
| * Inclement weather allowance (already included in the rate tables above) | \$0.80 per hour |
| * Industry allowance (already included in the rates table above) | \$0.78 per hour |
| Leading hand allowance | \$0.68 per hour, up to a maximum of \$25.96 per week |
| Meal allowance - overtime | \$14.80 for the first meal and \$14.80 for an extra meal after every 4 hours |
| Protective clothing and equipment reimbursement | reimbursement for the cost of purchasing any protective clothing and equipment required |
| Special clothing reimbursement | reimbursement for the cost of purchasing 3 sets of uniforms |
| Tool reimbursement | reimbursement for the cost of purchasing any tools required |
