## Allowances

Allowances	Rate
Excess fares reimbursement - working away from usual workplace	reimbursement of reasonable fares necessarily incurred in excess of the normal fares of travelling from home to the usual place of employment and return
Excess travel time payment - working away from usual workplace	payment at the appropriate rate for the time spent travelling in excess of normal travel time
Living away from home - fares allowance	payment for fares for travelling to and from work when living away from home
Living away from home - board and lodging reimbursement	reimbursement of reasonable expenses for board and lodging
Living away from home - travelling time	payment at the minimum hourly rate for all time spent in travelling between the employee's usual place of employment and the temporary location to a maximum of 7.6 hours per day
Meal allowance	\$11.99 for a meal
Vehicle allowance	\$0.78 per km
