Country work - lodging allowance	\$103.37 per night
Country work - travel time allowance	payment at the minimum hourly rate for each hour of travel to and from country work
Country work - meal allowance	\$9.55 per meal
First aid allowance	\$0.48 per hour up to a maximum of \$18.34 per week
First aid kit reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of maintaining a first aid kit
Fumigation depot allowance	\$8.05 for each day such work is performed
Verminous/decomposed human body allowance	\$103.48 on each occasion
Leading hand - in charge of 2-10 employees - payment in addition to the minimum wage for the highest classification supervised, or own minimum wage, whichever is higher	\$0.91 per hour up to a maximum of \$34.52 per week
Leading hand - in charge of 11-21 employees - payment in addition to the minimum wage for the highest classification supervised, or own minimum wage, whichever is higher	\$1.36 per hour up to a maximum of \$51.65 per week
Leading hand - in charge of more than 21 employees - payment in addition to the minimum wage for the highest classification supervised, or own minimum wage, whichever is higher	\$1.85 per hour up to a maximum of \$70.17 per week
Meal allowance - overtime	\$15.43 per meal
Vehicle allowance	\$0.91 per km
