If any all purpose allowances apply (marked *), they should be added to the minimum rate before penalties and overtime are calculated.

Allowances	Rate
First aid allowance	\$0.40 per hour up to a maximum of \$15.15 per week
Laundry allowance	\$0.70 per day
* Leading hand allowance - applies to grade 4 and below - in charge of 3-10 employees	\$0.89 per hour
* Leading hand allowance - applies to grade 4 and below - in charge of 11-20 employees	\$1.33 per hour
* Leading hand allowance - applies to grade 4 and below - in charge of more than 20 employees	\$1.68 per hour
Meal allowance	\$10.11 for the first meal and \$10.11 for the second meal
Special or protective clothing reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of purchasing special and/or protective clothing
Toilet cleaning allowance	\$2.45 per shift up to a maximum of \$12.05 per week
Vehicle allowance	\$0.78 per km
